### Visit Opportunity with the World Religion Center

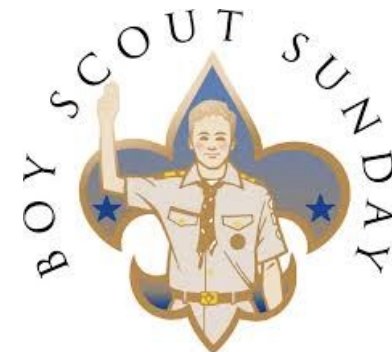
