Bill Fant, from Simpsonville, South Carolina, was privileged to participate in a Gideon International Scriptures Blitz in India. In one city where there was no Gideon Camp, a young Christian school teacher, Matthew, agreed to escort the team to the school locations one day.

As they traveled to the first school, Bill asked Matthew how he came to know Christ. Matthew shared he received a New Testament from the Gideons when he was in elementary school. He had come from a strict Hindu family and his father would not allow him to read it, so he read it secretly. As he continued reading the New Testament, he began to pray, and the Holy Spirit came into his life. Bill explained to Matthew that was the reason they were there in India – *To make sure others could have the same opportunity to read God's Word.*

As the day went on, Matthew shared more of his story. He said his mother has seen a change in his life after he came to know Christ. He showed her his New Testament, but she took it away from him. However, she began to read God's Word for herself, and it wasn't long before she gave her life to Christ. She then gave the same New Testament to Matthew's brother to read, and he surrendered his life to Christ.

Finally, Matthew's strict Hindu father read that same New Testament. It took longer, but he eventually gave his heart to Christ also. Matthew's entire family came to know the Lord from that **single New Testament**. *The whole family's legacy was changed not only here on earth but for eternity.*
